The Model 800 Steam Humidifier is specifically designed for residential environments where evaporative technology is not practical to employ.

Special Benefits of the Model 800 Steam Humidifier:

- **High capacities** of up to 23 gallons per day – A single unit provides capacity for many larger residential applications.
- **Easy and economical to maintain** canister/electrode technology. Simply replace the canister, usually on an annual basis.

- **More efficient; provides humidity when you need it** - Operates on a call for humidity. Controlling humidity is no longer dependent upon a call for heat from the thermostat.
- **Flexible installation** - Can be mounted directly on the duct or remote mounted up to 20 feet away from where the steam enters the duct. This is ideal in applications where the HVAC system is located in an attic or crawl space, or there are other obstructions or space limitations. For homes without ductwork, the Model 850 Fan Pack is available for remote applications.
- **Convenience** - Panel indicators tell the homeowner when the unit is operating and when it requires maintenance. ●
